15. 教学目标 Course Objectives

This course aims:

- 1. To nurture upon discussion of marriage and the family through emphasis upon contemporary forms of marriage and the family.
- 2. To examine the relationships between status and interpersonal relations in marriage and the family.
- 3. To analyze common marital and family problems in terms of causes, consequences, personal / family adjustments, preventive measures, and possible solutions.
- 4. To explore significant issues such as gender definition and socialization throughout the life cycle.

 as throughout the life-course;
- Explain, sociologically, major social forces that have created social problems and issues that pertain to intimate relationships, separation and divorce, and family violence;
