15. 教学目标 Course Objectives

本课通过对中国古代的衣食住行,也即物质生活方式及其在不同历史时期的演变之讨论,引导学生从物质生活的侧面理解中国的文化传统、文化心态,以及物质生活与精神生活的关系。This course aims to examine Chinese cultural history through a series of discussions on topics of material daily life, such as the ways Chinese dressed, dieted, lived and travelled in the traditional China. The objectives of the course are to guide and encourage students to explore and acquire better understanding of the meanings and mindset of Chinese popular culture and everyday life style in the context of traditional periods.
