15. 教学目标 Course Objectives

Specifically, this course aims to help the students:

The fundamental goal of the course is twofold. First, it is to introduce students to one of the sub-fields within the discipline of Political Science—Comparative Politics. Second, it is to provide students with opportunities to apply theoretical frameworks and concepts of Comparative Politics to comparing and studying different political systems. To achieve this goal, the class will

1. Introduce major theoretical frameworks and concepts of Comparative Politics;
2. Explore major social, political, economic, and cultural factors that influence the functions of various political systems;
3. Examine how governments operate in several major countries in the world;
4. Shed some light on global trends of sociopolitical development.

- 4、阐明全球社会政治发展趋势。
